KXRLG members voted in January 2004 to form a limited company and to apply for charitable status. The company was formed in July 2004 and an application was made for charitable status, with the intention of creating a charitable company. This application has been unsuccessful and we now propose to complete the move to being a limited company. Members are therefore being invited to two Annual General Meetings.

1. The closing AGM of the unincorporated KXRLG will be asked to agree a resolution transferring its assets to the limited company and to dissolve the group, closing the unincorporated association.

2. This will be followed immediately by the AGM of the limited company KXRLG. All member groups and individuals will be invited to formally join the new limited company. The meeting will confirm which members of the management committee will become Directors of the Company. The Company will also be asked pass an ordinary resolution to take responsibility for the group's debts.

In addition to the formal business of the AGMs, the meeting will provide a report of the work of the group in the last year and look at the challenges facing us in the coming period.

This has been a very busy period for the group. We do hope that all members will attend this meeting and help to decide direction for the coming period. If you wish to join for the first time or renew a lapsed membership you will be able to join or renew on the door.
