**Kings Cross Redevelopment - Judicial Review Pre-Action Protocol Letter to Camden LBC
regarding various Planning Resolutions**

We act for The King's Cross Railway Lands Group on whose behalf we have written to Camden Council, regarding various resolutions of its General Purposes (Development Control) Sub-Committee to grant planning permissions, listed building consents and conservation area consents on 09 March 2006 for redevelopment of King's Cross by Argent Limited.

The letter contains representations with regard to the future treatment of the resolutions, but also raises the prospect of a judicial review of the emerging decisions. It thus invokes the Judicial Review Pre-action Protocol.

We enclose a copy of the letter, which is duly served on Islington Council as an interested party. However, your attention is especially drawn to the contents of the letter as it understood that Islington will itself be making decisions which are pertinent to the resolutions cited, and thus may in due course also have to consider the issues raised and the possibility of legal challenge.
