It seems to me that prima facie both grounds are likely to be considered to be arguable. In those circumstances and in the light of the need for expedition, I think the sensible course is to direct a 'rolled-up' hearing to be held possibly at the end of this term but more probably at the beginning of next term when the whole issue can be determined.

In the meantime, no building which is listed or which may be required to be returned should be demolished.

I am sympathetic to the protective costs application, but the defendants must have the opportunity to make representations about it or its terms. This they can do within 21 days.

There is liberty to apply on 38 hours written notice.
